



## THE “EVELYN” VANITY TABLE - SCULPTURAL FURNITURE FROM DKT ARTWORKS

Very much born of the client's inspiration and part of a series of specially commissioned artworks and bespoke finishes for a residential project in the Rhineland, Germany, this hand-sculpted vanity unit employed a broad range of skills to achieve its unique appearance.

Mounted on a sturdy, stainless steel frame, the top is a sculpted vortex, cast in lead crystal and backed with burnt copper and silver leaf, creating the appearance of bubbling spring water, while the cut-away, anvil-shape permits uninhibited access to the basin.

The drawers are also constructed in stainless steel, with MDF cladding finished inside with a bird's-eye maple veneer. The exterior is overlaid with a hand sculpted skin finished in cold-spray metal, as is the monocoque carcass which pulls away to enable easy access to the services.

The harmoniously formed, hand-crafted drawer handles are located in the top pair of drawers, the lower ones following behind in a continuous movement when opened, reminiscent of the action of an opening fan.

The cold-spray, metal finishing is echoed in the bathroom suite by a pair of adjacent shower screens, sculpted in opposing, organic forms.
